CORONAVIRUS SAFE FITTING PROCEDURES

WHO'S IN THE ROOM?

- Limit the number of people to key players.
 - Designer, pattern maker, fit model, note taker
 - Having one note taker and one fitter helps to limit physical contact.
 - The note taker can also be the photographer to limit cross contamination.
 - Video is a great way to review the session again if necessary.
 - Set up your phone or camera on a tripod to minimize handling.
- Everyone must wear masks or face covering, including the model.
 - It can be uncomfortable after a while to wear masks, so face shields are a great solution.

WHAT'S IN THE ROOM?

- Limit exposure to one room
 - Create a private changing area for the model within the space
- Disinfect door handles, table tops, etc. before and after the fitting
- Keep hand sanitizer on hand
 - use before starting, and after the session (but it's nice to have available the whole time in case you find yourself needing to scratch an itch etc.)
- Keep a designated supply kit and keep these separate from your normal studio supplies. This way they can sit "quarantined" and be less likely to transmit germs or viruses since they don't live on surfaces for very long. Not sure what to include? See our handy list.







Clean Fitting Check List:

- □ Hand Sanitizer
- □ Disinfectant Wipes
- □ Face Masks/Face Shields
- □ Pins & Pin cushion*
- □ Tape Measure*
- □ Phone/Camera
- □ Tripod

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*Items that can be disinfected should be cleaned before and after. Items that are harder to disinfect like pins and pin cushions must be kept separate from general use and quarantined between fittings.
